(GPS: N52 19.729 E5 38.276)



Situated in the centre of the Netherlands. Approx. 31 kilometres from Apeldoorn. It is often used for themed scouting camps because of its excellent facilities (buildings, toilets, showers, camp fire pits, open spaces etc.).
